




Membership


ERIAC is a membership-based organization, bringing together Roma and non-Roma individuals and organizations.

Annual Outreach programs



ERIAC Outreach programs are international activities and initiatives financed by the Federal Foreign Office of the German Government.

The aim of the International Outreach Program is to introduce ERIAC to diverse audiences in places outside of ERIAC's headquarters in Berlin to ensure a bottom-up formation of the strategic directions of the organization based on Roma leadership. Since 2017 ERIAC has coordinated four Outreach programs.

2017 - International Cultural Outreach Program

7 international events took place in: Sevilla, Kraków, Prague, Budapest, Rome, Bucharest and Berlin

2018 - Cultural Institutions Network Initiative (CINI)

Focused on Balkans countries to engage more closely with the rich Roma arts and culture scene

2019 - Roma Tangible Heritage Network (RTHN)
Network for the institutions, organizations, and collectors who create the map of Roma tangible heritage in Europe

2020 - Roma Cultural History Initiative (RCHI)

4 initiatives: Romani Language Reform, Barvalipe Roma Online University, RomaMoMA, Identity Packages

RomaMoMA is a contemporary art project initiating a forum for collaborative reflection on a future Roma Museum of Contemporary Art, with the involvement of local and international, Roma and non-Roma artists, cultural experts, social scientists and the civil sphere. RomaMoMA is a joint initiative of ERIAC and OFF-Biennale Budapest. In the form of a contemporary art project, by means of involving stakeholder communities, and exploiting the possibilities of collective thinking and discourse, as well as the critical and discursive potentials of contemporary art, it -"prefiguratively" – "creates" itself: an imagined and yet real space that is home to both the Roma arts and artists.



Roma Language initiative

Through this initiative ERIAC and its partners continued the international work on the development of the Romani language, bringing together international experts with proven experience in the field for continuing the cooperation at international level and setting up common strategies and standards, but also developed teaching materials in Romani based on the Curriculum Framework for Romani and the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages developed by the Council of Europe. Actions:

- Created the database with Romani language teachers, translators and interprete
- Organized the International Conference for Romani Language on 5th November 2020
- Developed a printed Romani language textbook level A1 for adults


