

## Summary of the Joint meeting with the European Roma Institution for Art and Culture

## 11 August, 2021

The aim of the meeting is to establish a mutual dialogue and to foster potential collaboration between ERIAC and Baltic Roma NGOs as well as activists.

During the Joint meeting there are many issues highlighted by the participants:

- Develop co-operation and dialogue between ERIAC and the Baltic Roma NGOs in order to find ways to promote the cultural and historical diversity of the Baltic Roma in Europe.
- 2) Exchange practical information on cooperation opportunities and activities planned by ERIAC - ERIAC provides information on joint initiatives in which Roma NGOs in the Baltic States could participate and submit proposals for financial support for their local initiatives.
- 3) Develop sustainable communication (regular meetings at least once per year) between ERIAC and Baltic Roma NGOs to discuss a collaboration for implementing local initiatives (digitalization of the material of Museum, Roma language archive, exhibitions etc.).
- 4) The Draft of the Strategic plan for future co-operation will be discussed at the next meetings between ERIAC and the Baltic Roma NGOs.
