## INVITATION

The Baltic Sea Region plays an important role in the development of the European Union. In 2009 it became the first area in the EU which adopted a macro-regional Programme, the European Union Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region (EUSBSR). With this strategy, the region strives to improve the international competitiveness, the ecological condition of the Baltic Sea as well as social cohesion.

Our event will concentrate on presenting four EU key funding programmes: CERV, Horizon, Erasmus +, and Interreg. Representatives from city administrations, local businesses, NGOs, universities, and other stakeholders in the Baltic Sea Region are invited to join our event on March 9th and 10th. Moreover, the City of Rostock, the Union of the Baltic Cities as a regional network, and the European Integration Centre will present their initiatives and strategies for the development of crossborder cooperation.

The event consists of two parts. On March 9th , general information about the EU funding programmes will be presented. In doing so, we also concentrate on the target groups of the programmes, highlight application deadlines, and show the project costs that are eligible for funding. On March 10th, we give detailed insights into funding opportunities and application processes and introduce into Best Practice Cases, branching out into smaller working groups as we do so.
