Its work combines film circulation, audience development, cultural mediation, education, and support for emerging talent. Palatine develops projects connecting cinemas, schools, universities, festivals, artists and young audiences through screenings, debates, workshops, training activities and international cultural events. Its core mission is to make European cinema more accessible and meaningful for younger generations while fostering intercultural dialogue and critical thinking.
Role of the organisation in the project	Association Palatine intends to act as project leader and coordinating organisation. It will oversee the overall artistic and strategic direction of the project, partnership coordination, communication, audience development, transnational mobility activities, and dissemination. It will also contribute directly to the design of educational and cultural formats linking film screenings, workshops, meetings with artists and participatory audience engagement.

Description or summary of the proposed project	<b>YES (Young European Stars)</b> aims to create a transnational platform connecting cinema, music and visual arts in order to bring European cultural works closer to young audiences aged 15 to 25. Bringing together cultural organisations, cinemas,

	<p>festivals, educational actors and creative professionals from several European countries, the project will develop innovative formats combining artistic creation, audience engagement and cultural participation.</p> <p>The project will focus in particular on teenagers and young adults, with special attention to audiences that have limited access to European cultural content. Through screenings, film literacy activities, interdisciplinary workshops, meetings with artists and participatory events, <b>YES</b> will encourage young audiences not only to discover European works, but also to interpret, discuss and engage with them critically and creatively. The project will pay special attention to teenagers and young adults with limited access to European cultural content, while fostering cross-border cooperation and testing transferable models for audience development at European level.</p>
Partners currently involved in the project	At this stage, the project is being developed by Association Palatine in dialogue with partners in France and Italy active in the fields of music, visual arts, cinema, cultural mediation and European cooperation. The partnership is currently being expanded to include organisations from additional Creative Europe countries, especially festivals, film, music and arts education structures, cultural associations, and organisations experienced in youth participation and audience development.
