Short description of the project, including its aims	Through this project we want to commemorate martyrs who were victims of totalitarian regimes of the 20 th century and develop tools that help interpret their martyrdom in the 21th century. The project also looks into the life of frontier zones during the cold war, towns or regions separated from its foreign neighbours as well as from the rest of its own country — and analyses the effects of this special closeness to the people's mindset and to the martyrdom itself. Through different activities such as research, conference, youth exchange and exhibition we look into their life trying to understand the values they suffered for, the system of totalitarian regimes that allowed these crimes and its implication on people's mind in the past and present. The project looks into the topic from perspectives of various disciplines and generations with an emphasis of the youth. The project will develop a methodology handbook and an exhibition with sociopoly which offer contemporary methods of forward-looking remembrance.
