

RESTORATION OF THE GREAT SYNAGOGUE OF LUDZA AND REVIVAL OF JEWISH SPIRITUAL HERITAGE

Project description: The Great synagogue of Ludza is a culture (architecture) monument of state importance and is the oldest synagogue in Latvia and Baltic States; it is located in the area of another monument – the Historical Centre of Ludza Town. The Synagogue is considered to be a unique cultural monument of Jewish in north-eastern Europe, which mostly have been lost elsewhere in Europe during the 20th century. In order to keep the culture and historical heritage and to ensure qualitative access to culture services for the society, the synagogue building will be restored and expositions will be created.
